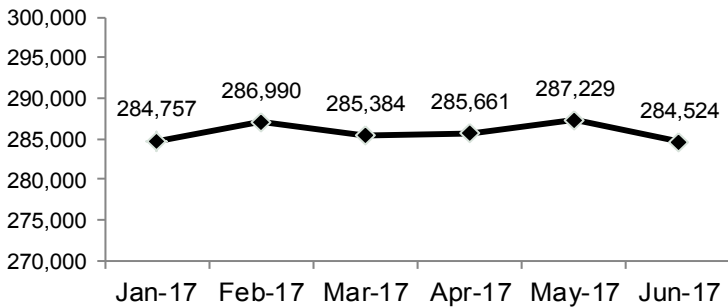

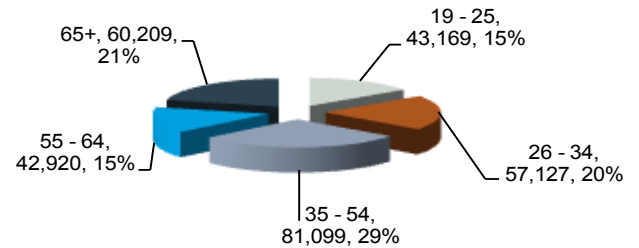

### Adult Enrollment Trend



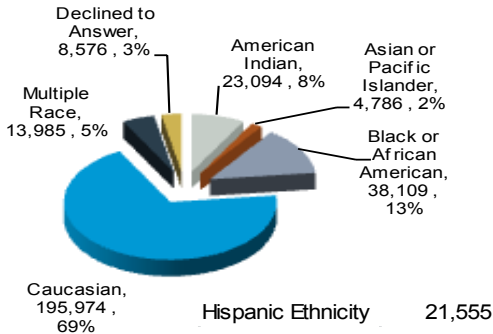
### Age Breakdown of Adult Enrollment
