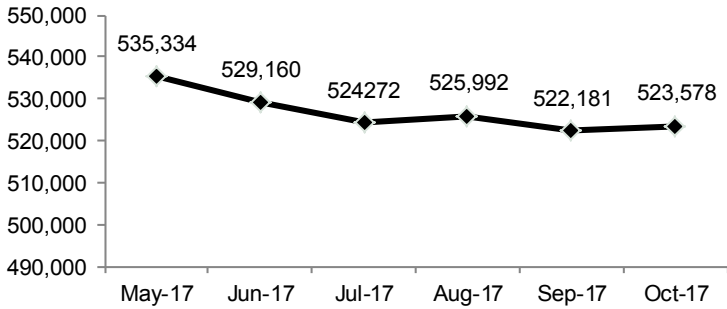

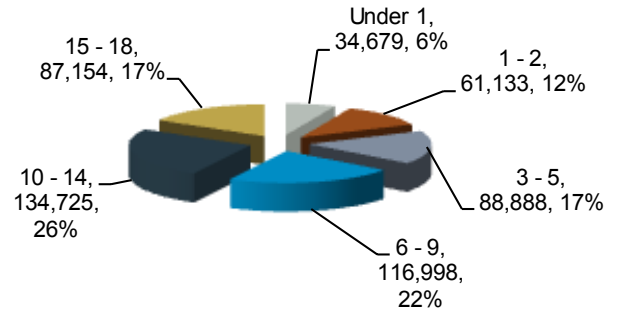

### Age Breakdown of Child Enrollment

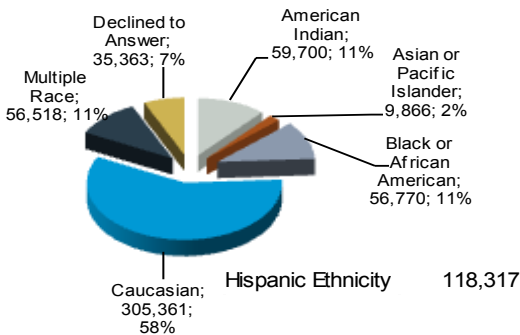
