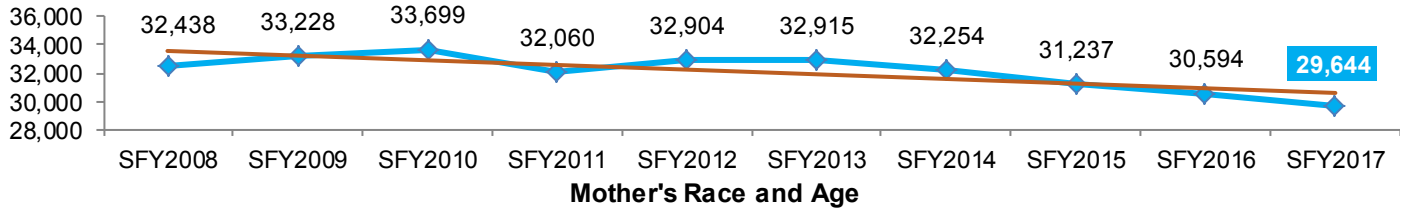


SoonerCare Delivery Fast Facts

SFY2017

Below are the delivery figures of SoonerCare members with paid claims for date of service during the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017. Data is based on mother's claims with a delivery code, it does not represent live births. Mothers with multiple delivery dates will be counted multiple times; mothers having multiple babies on the same day will be counted once. Data may include members with TPL (Third Party Liability) or Medicare.

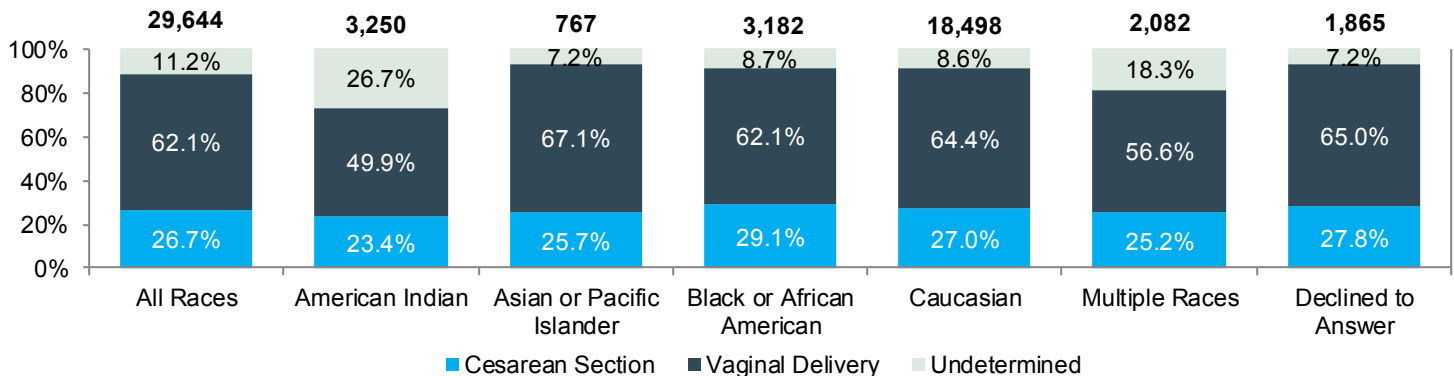

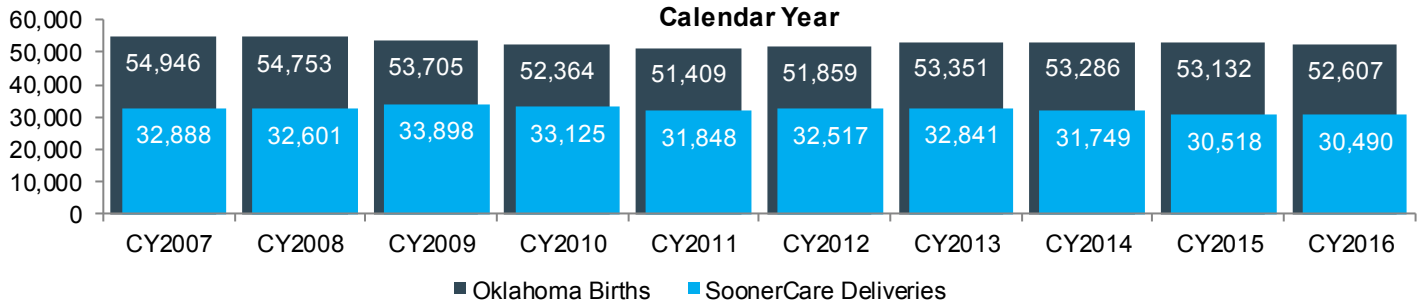
Race is self-reported by members at the time of enrollment. Members selected two or more races are group in the multiple races category. Hispanic is an ethnicity instead a race, it can be of any race and is accounted for in a race category. Data is based on mother's age at the time of delivery.

Inpatient Delivery



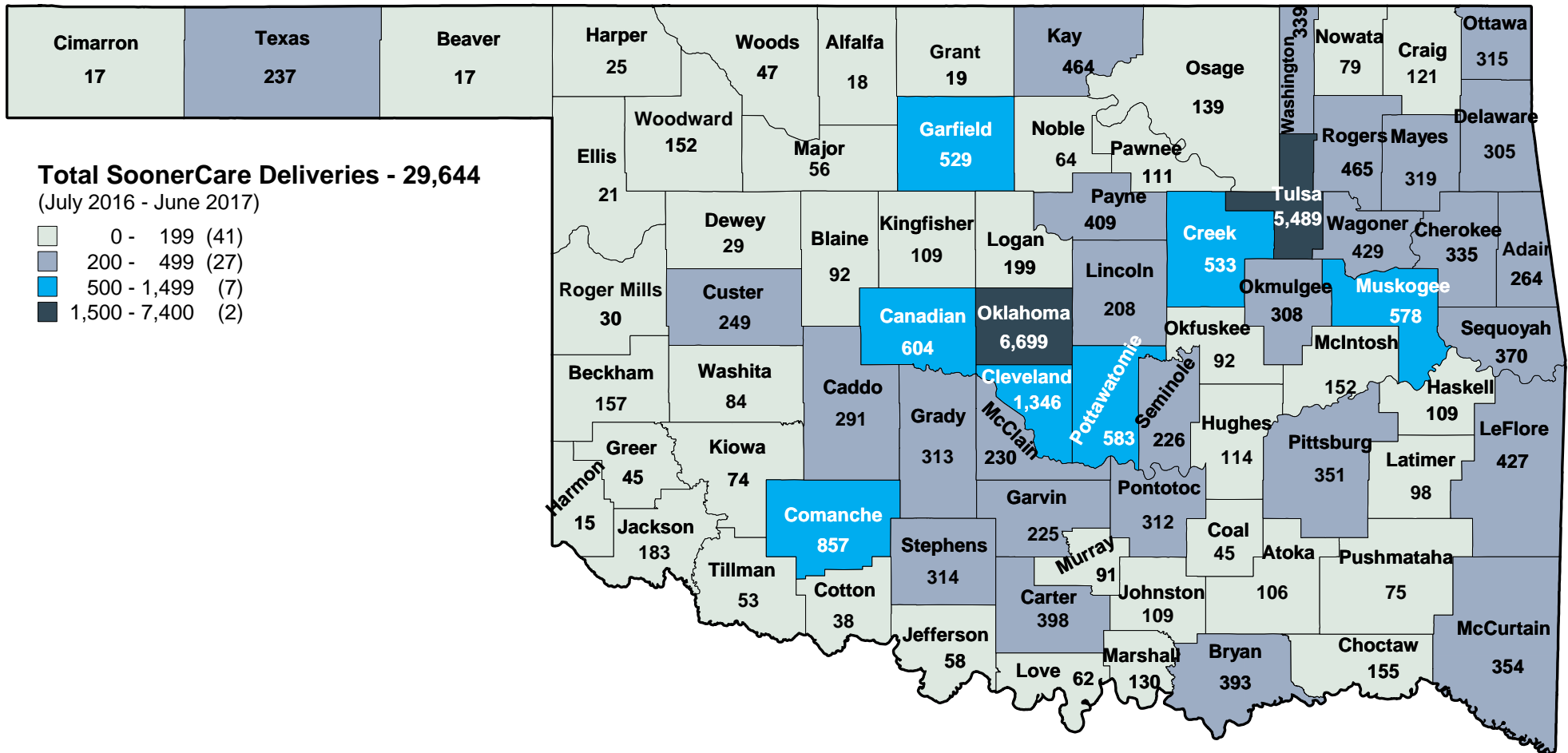
Data is based on DRG (Diagnosis Related Grouping) from inpatient claims. However, IHS (Indian Health Services) facilities do not use DRG to bill, these deliveries are being counted as Undetermined, which is reflected on the American Indian population. Undetermined are deliveries without a corresponding paid inpatient claim at the time data was collected.

Oklahoma Births figures are from Oklahoma State Department of Health (does not include out-of-state births) and SoonerCare Deliveries figures are from OHCA (includes out-of-state deliveries which paid for by SoonerCare). Birth refers to live birth and delivery refers to a paid claim with a delivery code, it does not represent live births.
