

OHCA Online Enrollment Fast Facts

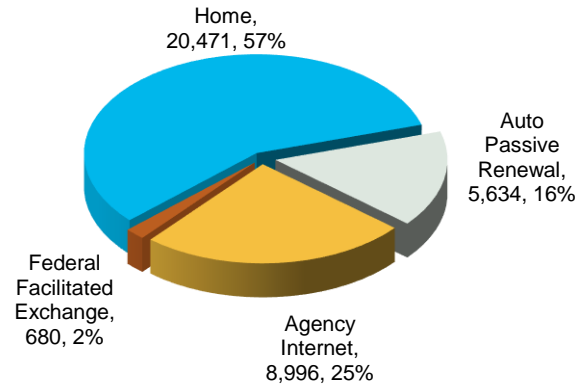

Online Enrollment enhances eligibility determination by accepting applications over the internet. Individuals now have the opportunity to apply for **SoonerCare, SoonerPlan, Soon-to-be Sooners, Insure Oklahoma, and Behavioral Health** programs on the internet and receive immediate results from the information they have submitted.

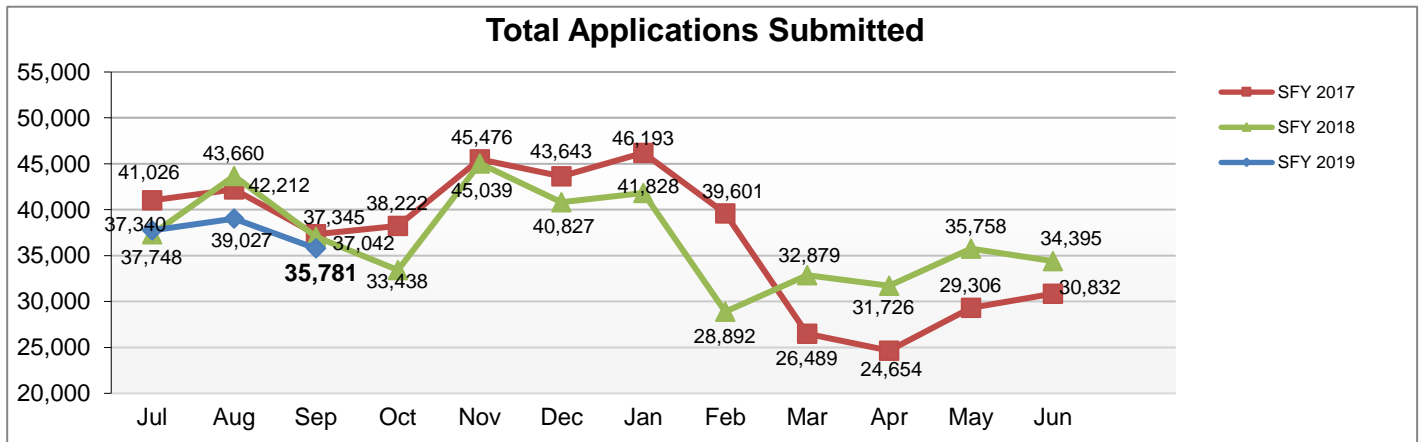

The **Media Type** tracks how the information (application) was submitted. Some rural areas may not have Internet access, therefore might continue submitting their information on paper applications. Agency Electronic consist of partner agencies submitting applications on behalf of the patient and/or recipient/member.

-Agencies and provider partners may have Paper, Internet, or Agency Electronic Media Type.
-Members are passively renewed when their income and other criteria is met.
