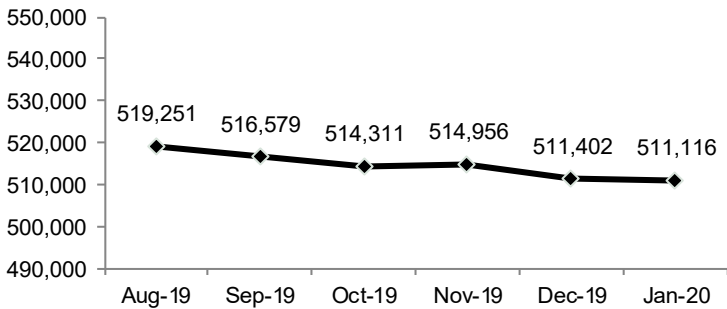

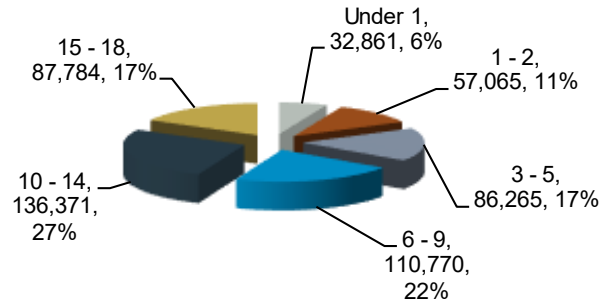

## Age Breakdown of Child Enrollment

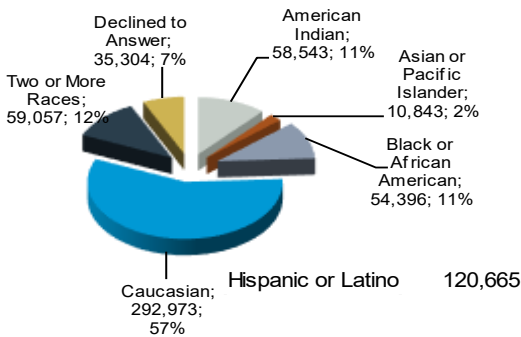
