Dear Provider:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority (OHCA) is informing Oklahoma school districts that there is a possibility that the Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) (formerly Health Care Financing Administration [HCFA]) will disapprove the OHCA's pending State Plan Amendment for Targeted Case Management (TCM) in school districts. Therefore, OHCA recommends that school districts cease billing for TCM services to minimize their amount of federal dollars that may be subject to recoupment. However, providers should continue to document their TCM services pending the outcome of this State Plan Amendment.

This recommendation is made as a safeguard measure following discussions between CMS and the OHCA Policy Division. Please be assured that OHCA will continue working with CMS in an effort to resolve this matter.
