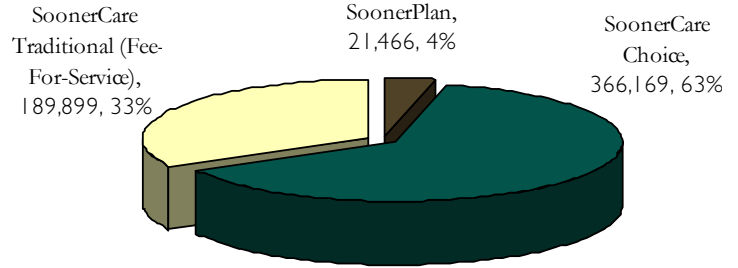

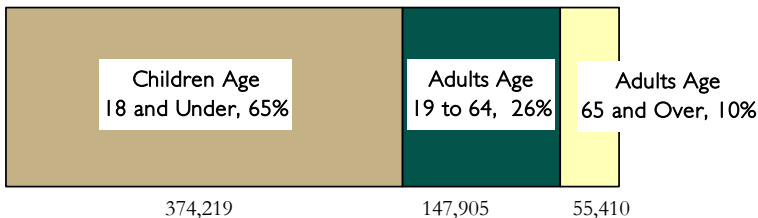

Age Breakdown of Total Enrollment



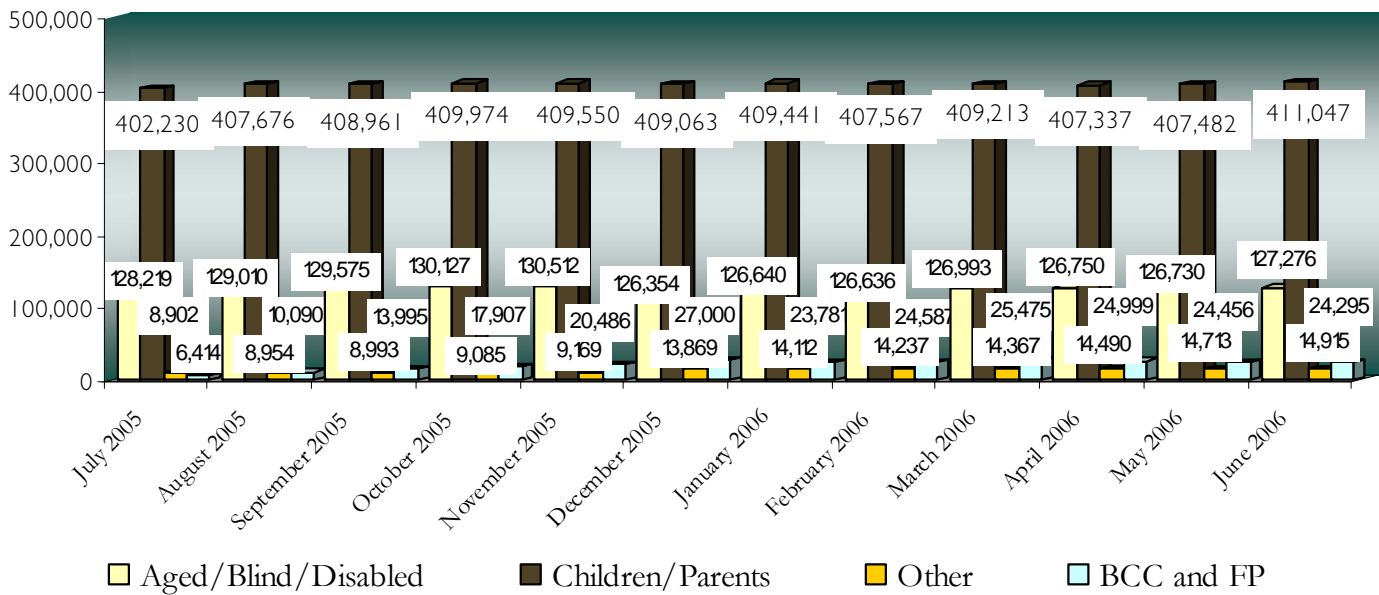
SCHIP Breakdown of Total Enrollment

OHCA dentist selected for Fellowship

Oklahoma Health Care Authority dentist Dr. Leon D. Bragg has been invited to Fellowship in the American College of Dentists according to Dr. Robert L. Phillips of Oklahoma City.

The American College of Dentists (ACD) is a non-profit professional organization comprised of dentists who have demonstrated exceptional leadership and contributions to the profession and their community. Since its founding in 1920, The ACD has been vital in identifying and responding to issues affecting dentistry, oral health, and society. Utilizing the knowledge and skills of its Fellow, the College is pursuing initiatives to expand leadership in the dental profession and address the many challenges ahead. A major focus of the College is ethics and professionalism.

According to Dr. Phillips, Dr. Bragg will join an elite group of colleagues. Fellowship in the American College of Dentists is a distinct honor that is bestowed only if the accomplishments of the nominee are truly outstanding and epitomize excellence. The acceptance letter states, “selection to Fellowship reflects your exceptional leadership, achievements, and involvement in the dental profession and in your community. It also recognizes your ability to offer new insights and direction for dentistry and oral health.” Currently, fewer than 80 of the state’s 1,500 plus dentists have been accepted for Fellowship.

“I am really grateful to my sponsors, Dr. Phillips and Dr. M.G. Duncanson, Jr., for their belief that my professional stature deserved such an honor. I will forever remember their belief in my accomplishments. I will certainly wear my new title with honor,” Dr. Bragg said.
